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## MONTHLY SUMMARY OF EXTERNAL TRADE STATISTICS AUGUST 2022

### Background

The Zimbabwe National Statistics Agency (ZIMSTAT) produces the monthly summary of External Trade Statistics report using data on merchandise statistics from the Zimbabwe Revenue Authority (ZIMRA) and secondary statistics from companies and trade organizations. This report shows monthly exports and imports by broad economic categories such as food and beverages, industrial supplies, fuels and lubricants, capital goods, transport equipment, consumer goods and goods not elsewhere classified. It further shows main exports and imports by Harmonized System codes of trade products, destination of exports and source country of imports.

### Trends in External Trade





















Export drivers are closely monitored in order to strengthen the country's export earning capacity. Data for August 2022 shows that Zimbabwe's main exports were semi-manufactured gold (30.2%), nickel mattes including platinum group of minerals (PGMs), (19.7%), nickel ores and concentrates (14.3%), tobacco (9.0%), ferro-chromium (7.3%), platinum unwrought or in powder form (3.0), coke and semi-coke of coal (2.6%), (Figure 1).

During the month of August 2022, the country exported semi-manufactured gold valued at US\$149.1 million, signifying a decline from US\$195.7 million in July 2022. In the same month of August 2022, the country exported 16,072 tonnes of nickel ores and concentrates valued at US\$70.5 million, compared to 26,035 tonnes valued at US\$169.6 million in July 2022. Besides the major minerals usually exported, Zimbabwe also exported 7 kilogrammes of industrial diamonds valued at US\$7.0 million in August 2022, while in July 2022, a total of 7 kilogrammes valued at US\$ 6.1 million were exported, (Table 3.1e).

Mineral fuels and mineral oil products remained Zimbabwe's major imports accounting for 22.2% of the total value of imports in August 2022, compared to 19.4% in July 2022. This was followed by machinery and mechanical appliances at 12.7% in August 2022. Other imports in August 2022 included animal/vegetable fats and oils (3.5%), vehicles (8.0%), (Figure 1).

Notably, the value of major imports in Zimbabwe aggregate to 92.6% of total value of imports in August 2022. The value of cereal imports including maize increased from 3.1% of total value of imports in July 2022, to 5.0% in August 2022. Rice, which makes the bulk of cereal imports constituted 2.3% of total value of imports in August 2022, compared to 1.4% in July 2022. The value of maize (excluding seed) imported remained low at 0.5% of total value of imports in July 2022 compared to 0.7% in August 2022, (Table 3.2d).

**Figure 1: Zimbabwe's Major Exports and Imports (%) August 2022**

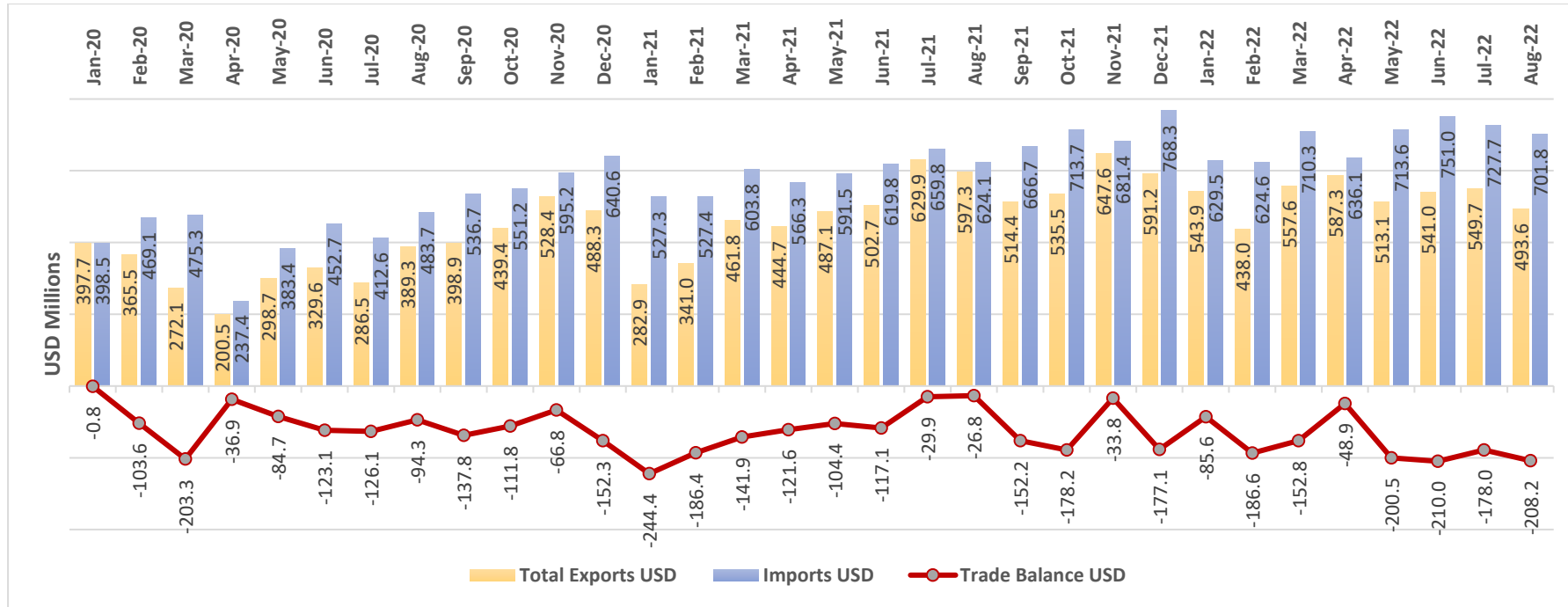

### Major Trading Partners

South Africa remained Zimbabwe's major trading partner. In August 2022, the value of exports to South Africa were 44.5% of the total value of exports, compared to 38.9% in July 2022. Exports to United Arab Emirates constituted 30.6% in August 2022, compared to 36.0% in July 2022. Value of exports to China decreased to 6.4% in August 2022, from 7.5% in July 2022. Exports to Mozambique constituted 6.5% in July 2022, being a decrease to 2.7% in August 2022, (Table 5.1c)

The proportion of imports from South Africa was 38.3% in August 2022, compared to 38.8% in July 2022. Further, the proportion of the value of imports from Singapore increased to 16.2% in August 2022, from 13.9% in July 2022. The value of imports from China decreased to 12.0% in August 2022, from 17.6% in July 2022. Other imports in August 2022 came from Mozambique (4.5%), Zambia (3.8%), India (3.2%), Mauritius (2.9%), United Arab Emirates (2.6%), Argentine (1.4%), Hong Kong (1.2%) Belarus (0.9%), and United Kingdom (0.8%), (Table 5.2c)

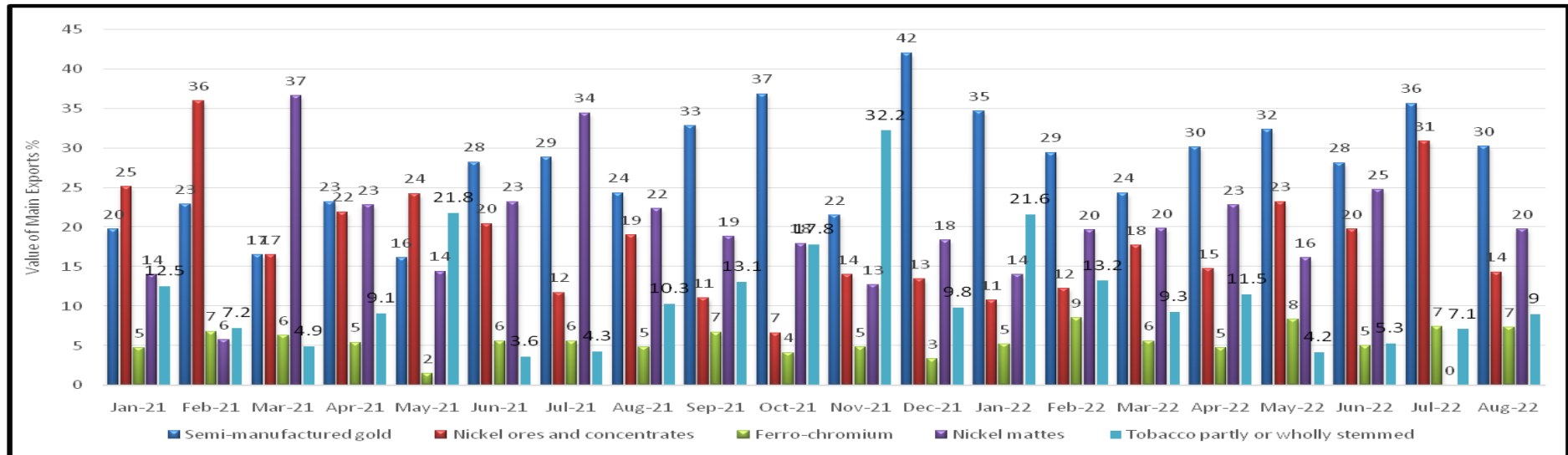

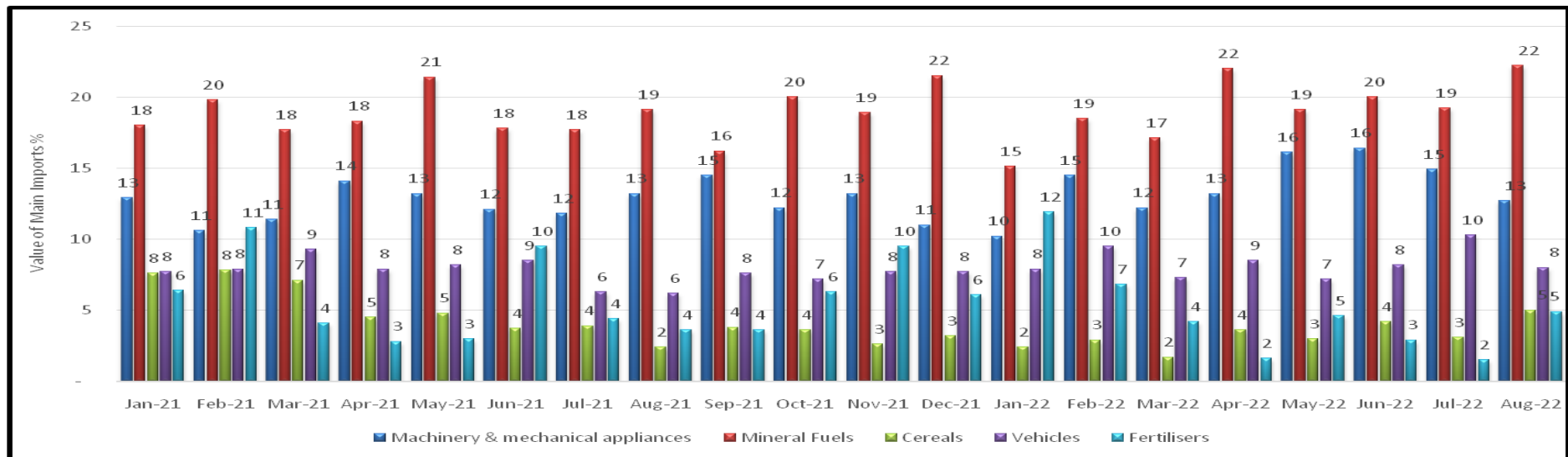

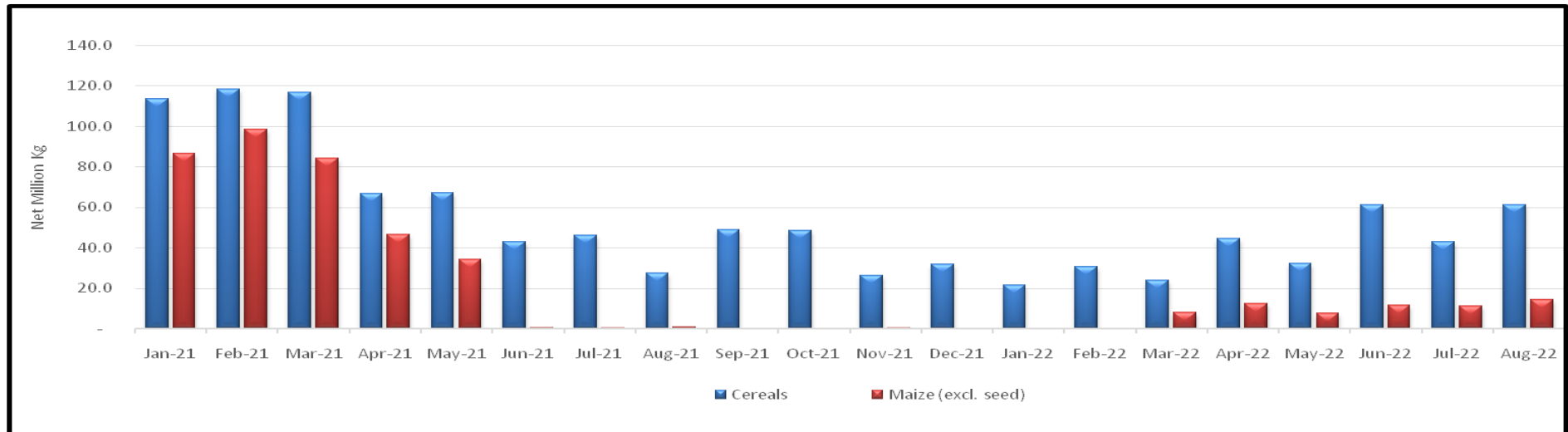
**Figure 3a: Value of Main Exports by Harmonized System Product Codes (%) January 2021 to August 2022**

**Figure 4: Quantity of Cereals Imported (Net Million Kg); January 2021 to August 2022**

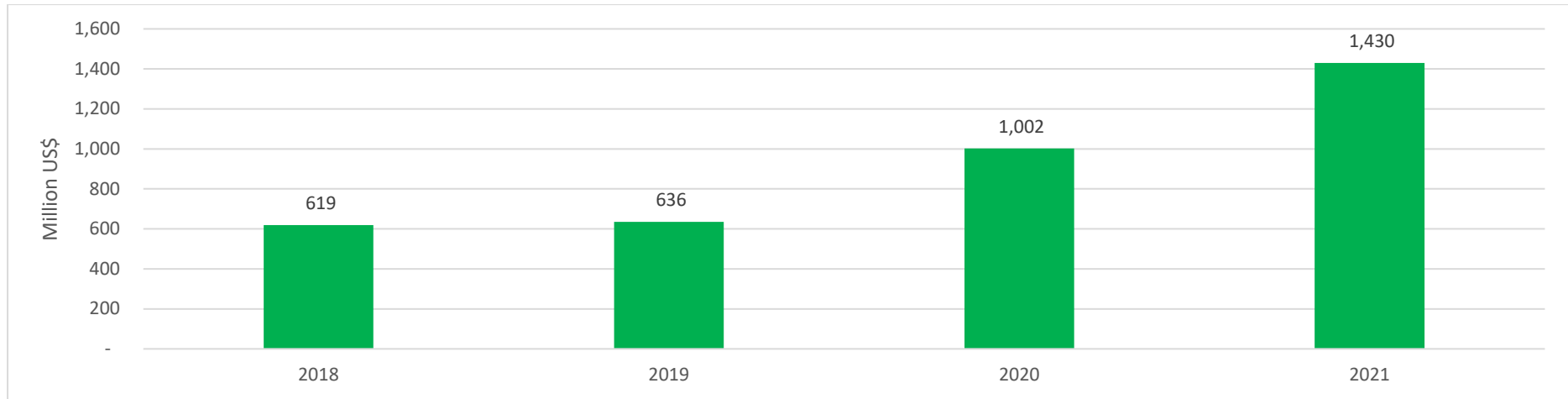

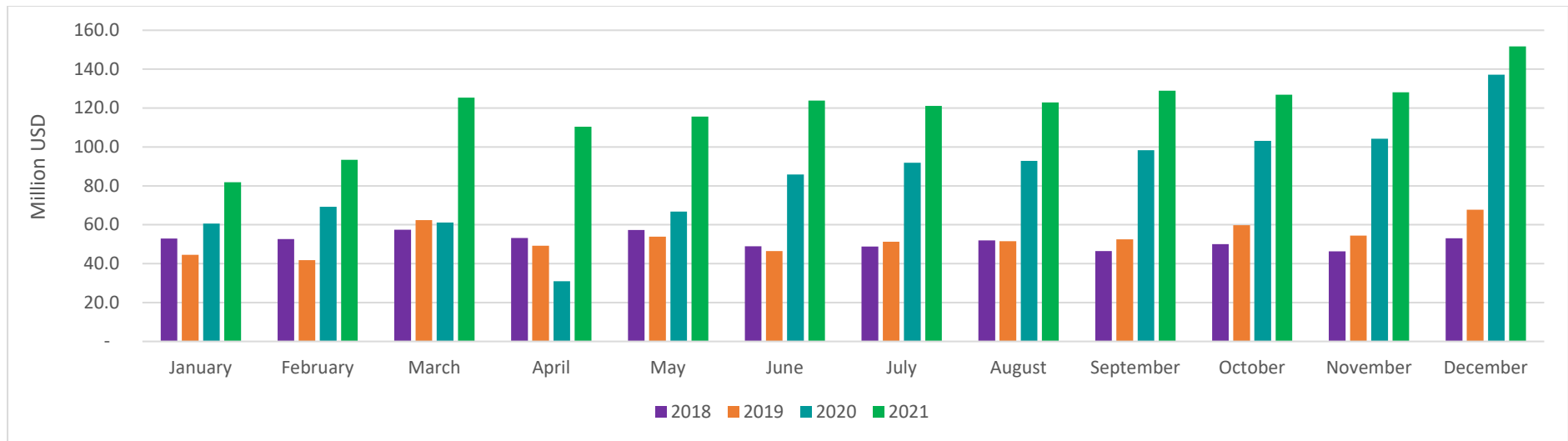

## ANNEX: EXTERNAL TRADE METHODOLOGY AND COMPILATION OF STATISTICS

### Source of Data

The main source of trade statistics is customs bills of entry. Whenever a good is imported or exported a customs bill of entry is completed pertaining to the nature of the good and the importation/exportation details involved. This is done for customs purposes. The Zimbabwe Revenue Authority (ZIMRA) uses the Automated System of Customs Data Administration (ASYCUDA), and the Zimbabwe National Statistics Agency (ZIMSTAT) receives soft copies of bills of entry with monthly details of data by port. This means that data capture is done by the customs department of ZIMRA. A file is received by email after the end of each month. Trade in electrical energy is external data collected from ZESA on a monthly basis and is imported into the main system using a special importation scheme based in Excel.

At ZIMSTAT the data is imported or loaded into the Eurotrace System. Eurotrace is a system specifically designed to produce trade statistics using ASYCUDA data. In Eurotrace, the data is stored and updated every month. The columns are 55 with records of a single product like Day, Office, Declaration type, Declaration number, Item number, Forwarding Agent, Trader, Customs procedure code, etc. The rows are records or entries for the month which on average are 90,000.

### Concepts and Scope of Trade Statistics

**Domestic Exports** are goods of Zimbabwean origin, include goods produced domestically and those originally imported that have undergone a process of transformation. They are valued free on board (FOB). Excluded are goods consigned to diplomatic and other official missions.

**Re-exports:** are goods, materials or articles originally imported which are exported either in the same conditions in which they were imported or after going minor operations like blending, packing, bottling, cleaning or sorting.

**Total Exports:** The aggregate of domestic exports of Zimbabwean origin and re-exports.

**Imports:** Goods imported into the country directly for home consumption or use and those going into customs bonded warehouses. In addition to commercial transactions, the other items included are imports of goods for which no foreign currency was involved (NCI) such as migrants' effects. Imports are valued Cost Insurance and Freight (CIF).

### Coverage

- i. Gold bullion is excluded.
- ii. Goods imported for repair and return are included with exports.
- iii. Re-exports consists of the export of imported goods other than goods imported for repairs.
- iv. Migrant's effects.
- v. Goods on direct transit, i.e. goods being transported or moved through Zimbabwe are excluded.
- vi. Imports by and exports to diplomatic and other official foreign missions are excluded.

- vii. Imports of returned exports are included in imports.
- viii. Postal traffic is included without a commodity breakdown.

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
